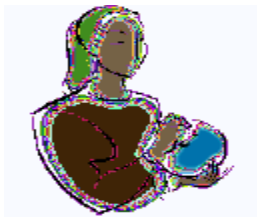
Announcing the upcoming

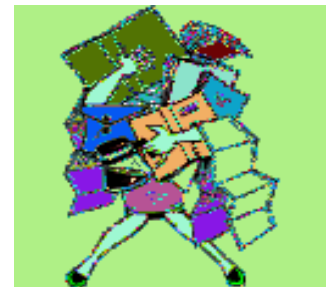
Make plans to attend the Annual meeting in April, open to all DWBA members. The place and time will be announce at a later date.

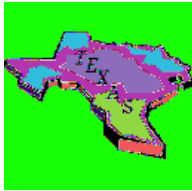
THE 10TH BOARD SPOTLIGHT –
