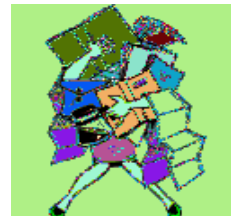
I would remind the secretaries of various leagues to send for the awards as the bowlers earn them. We need to recognize their achievements on the lanes.

**THE DWBA BOARD
WORKING FOR YOU
IN 2003 AND 2004.**

The following is a list of the acts of the DWBA Board working for you from November, 2003 through September 2004 that was presented at the Annual Meeting on September 9, 2004.

On November 2003 the DWBA joined forces with the Dallas Bowling Association in promoting SOLV to the local bowlers in support of our veterans. Between the two organizations over \$19,000 was given to the local Overturn Veterans Hospital.

On January 30, 2004, the DWBA hosted the Bowl for the Cure at Don Carter West. Over \$50,000 was raised in support of Komen Breast Cancer Research. We were able to raise more than \$50,000 last year to beat Milwaukee for the 4th year in a row.

In March 2004 the Annual City Tournament was held at Don Carter West. Though entries were down, it was a successful tournament.

In June 2004, the DWBA's elected State delegates attended the State Convention in Houston. State Officials were elected for the 2004-2005 season.

In July 2004 the DWBA hosted the Metro Mixed Tournament at ASMF Irving Lanes. Another successful tournament.

In August 2004 several DWBA Board Members attended a workshop in Victoria, Texas. The principal speaker was Roseann Kuhn from National Headquarters. Her mission was to help all of us understand the pros and cons of merging the organization.

At the DWBA Board Meeting on August 30, three people were elected to represent the DWBA at an initial joint meeting to discuss the merging of the different organizations (DWBA, DBA and YABA) in the Dallas area. These were presented at the Annual Meeting for approval.

On September 25, 2004 the DWBA hosted our annual Las Vegas party which is a fundraiser to support the women's local awards program in the Dallas area.

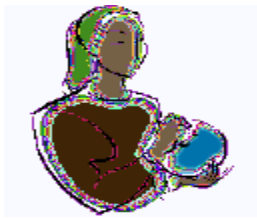
**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING

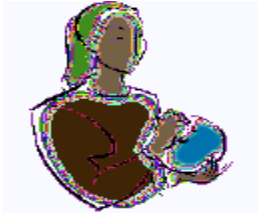
